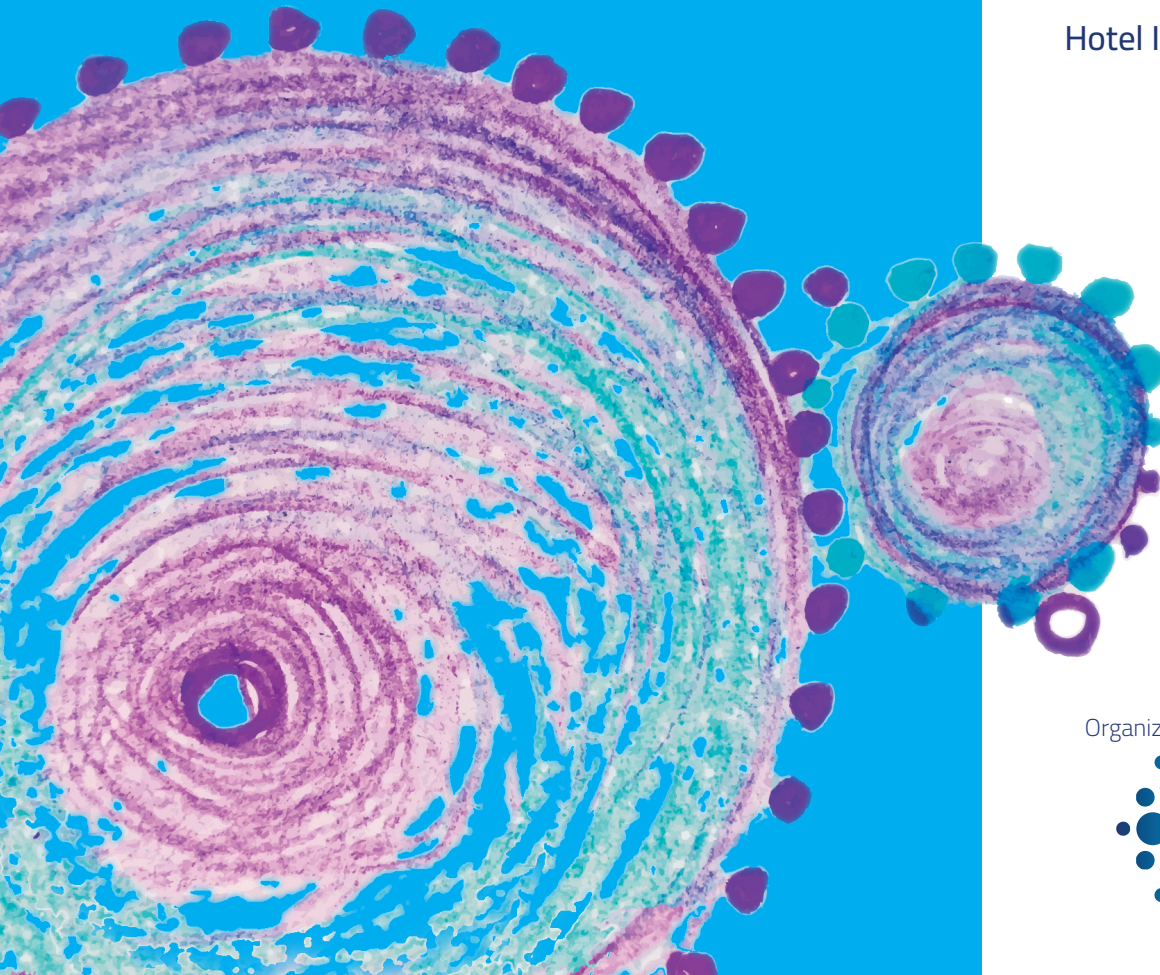

CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

Submissions accepted for the 12th Forum on Translational Immunology and Cancer Immunotherapy –FIT-Cancer 12– will be published in an Abstract Book format, preferentially in an indexed scientific journal to be determined (see previous **Abstract Books here**). The Scientific Committee reserves the right to decide if an Abstract is not suitable for publication.

Abstracts must be written in English, and the submitting author is responsible for ensuring the accuracy of all information (including affiliations and the correct use of English or abbreviations). Please note that GÉTICA will not make any changes to the final version, which will be made public during the symposium and in the publication.

Abstracts will be selected by the Scientific Committee to be presented either as a poster or as an oral presentation.

Works that have not been previously published or presented at other conferences will be given preference. Updated results from previously reported work (whether as a conference presentation or a research article) may be submitted if the submitting author provides references of previous published results.

Submitting a work for consideration at the conference implies the participant's complete and unconditional acceptance of these terms.

Note that proposals sent by any other means will not be considered.

Proposals must be submitted online no later than 11:59pm (CET) on December 15, 2025.

The Scientific Committee will award a prize for the best oral communication (250€) and for the best poster (100€), which will be selected by the Evaluation Committee (composed of GÉTICA representatives and selected participants of the symposium). The prize announcement and award ceremony will take place during the closing session of FIT-Cancer 12.

The awardees will be asked to prepare a video (of up to 3 minutes in length) for dissemination via the digital media of GÉTICA.

By submitting your work, you consent to include authors' names, affiliation, biographical material and the summary on the website of the symposium as well as in indexes or search databases in print, electronic, or other media.

RULES OF THE CALL

Proposals presenting results of basic, translational, clinical, epidemiological, and/or computational research in the area of cancer immunology and/or cancer immunotherapy are welcome. Proposals may also include results of clinical experiences of interest with immunotherapies in cancer patients.

In this edition, a maximum of 3 proposals will be selected for oral presentations. Priority will be given to the presentation of work that focuses on any of the following thematic areas:

- Cell therapies
- New immunotherapy strategies for cancer treatment
- Biomarkers of response or toxicity to immunotherapy
- Integration of immunotherapies into multimodal treatments
- Mechanisms of response/resistance to immunotherapy

The presentation of a work implies the physical presence at the congress of the person who will present it, who must be duly registered. If the first author is unable to attend the conference, they may delegate the presentation to a co-author; however, this delegation must be notified to the Secretariat in advance, and the presenting co-author must also be registered and attend in person.

First authors who submit abstracts will be eligible to apply for a LIMITED number of FIT Cancer 12 registration grants. Please note that submitting an abstract does NOT guarantee the award of a grant. Applicants wishing to be considered must indicate it at the time of abstract submission. As the number of grants is limited, we strongly encourage early bird registration to secure reduced fees regardless of the outcome.

An author may present more than one proposal, as she/he deems appropriate.

RULES FOR PREPARING AND SUBMITTING PROPOSALS

The abstracts of the proposals must be in English, in a PDF or a Word format, with the following structure:

- **Title:** The title should be capitalized and no longer than 25 words.
- **Authors** (first and last names): The first author should be the person in charge of presenting the proposal.

- **Affiliation of the first author:** The place of work should be selected among those offered by the system. These data are mandatory. If it is not on the list, use the “Other work center” box to include it and fill in all the requested data (e.g., name, address, telephone, fax, etc.).
- **Abstract:** The abstract has a limit of 350 words and should contain the following sections:
 - Introduction and Objectives
 - Materials and Methods
 - Results
 - Conclusions
- In the final line, grants or other funding sources for the work should be indicated.
- Figures and tables (maximum 3) must be attached as image files (.jpg). Each figure or table must include an appropriate legend. For images containing multiple panels or subfigures, each panel must be clearly labeled (e.g., 1a, 1b, 1c).
- No references to personal or identifying data of patients or their relatives should be included.

As a final step, you must attach an additional version in Word format that does NOT INCLUDE AUTHOR NAMES OR AFFILIATIONS; the figure images and/or tables should be inserted into this document.

If you are submitting more than one work as a first author, you must use the same username, password, and e-mail for all the submitted proposals.

SELECTION PROCESS

- All proposals will be evaluated by the Selection Committee, and the results will be communicated as soon as possible, by late January to early February 2026. For accepted works, the format in which it will be presented (oral or poster) and the expected date and time of the presentation will be provided.
- Proposals will be classified as oral or poster presentation based on the criteria of the Selection Committee and the availability of time and space. Inclusion in the Abstract Book will also depend on the criteria of the Scientific Committee.
- The Technical Secretariat will send the results of the evaluation to the first author of the proposal, indicating the date, time, and room for the presentation.

EVALUATION CRITERIA

- All submitted proposals will be peer-reviewed by the Selection Committee designated by GÉTICA.
- Abstracts will be assessed according to the following general criteria:
 - **Scientific quality** and robustness of methodology.
 - **Originality and innovation** of the work.

- **Relevance** to the field of cancer immunology and/or cancer immunotherapy.
- **Clarity** in the presentation of objectives, results, and conclusions.
- **Potential impact** on research, clinical practice, or patient care.

All accepted posters will be displayed and their authors are required to be present during the official poster session to defend their work and answer questions from attendees. In addition, a limited number of posters, selected according to the score obtained by their abstracts, will be formally evaluated by the Scientific Committee.

- The awards for *Best Oral Presentation* and *Best Poster* will be granted based on the Evaluation Committee's assessment of the works presented in person, considering both the scientific quality and the quality of the delivery.
- The decisions of the Evaluation Committee will be final.

RULES FOR PRESENTING AN ACCEPTED WORK

Oral presentations

- A maximum of 3 proposals will be selected for oral presentations. Each oral presentation will have a strict time limit of 5 minutes, followed by 2 minutes for discussion. All presentations must be emailed or delivered on a USB drive to the Technical Secretariat at least 24 hours before the session begins.
- The slide presentations (PowerPoint, etc.) for oral presentations must be prepared in English. The presentation must be given in English.

Posters

- Posters should have a maximum size of 120 cm in height and 90 cm in width. All accepted posters will be displayed in the designated poster area during the congress.
- All accepted posters will be displayed and their authors are required to be present during the official poster session to defend their work and answer questions from attendees. In addition, a limited number of posters, selected according to the score obtained by their abstracts, will be formally evaluated by the Scientific Committee.

The first author (or the designated presenting author) of the posters selected for defense must be present during the official evaluation session to discuss the work and answer questions.
